The Cleveland East Chapter of the Institute of Management Accountants was formed from members of the Cleveland Chapter and its charter was granted on April 1, 1969. The Chapter's initial meeting was held at the Holiday Inn – East. Cleveland East's first president was Robert S. Durnwald, who also served on the National Board of Directors.

The Cleveland East Chapter has approximately 100 members as of June 1, 2009. Most of the businesses represented by Cleveland East Chapter members are located in the eastern half of Cuyahoga County and western half of Lake and Geauga Counties. Cleveland East has grown from a beginning membership of 87.
